

LARTON FISHING RULES

1. You MUST pay at the Feed Store before setting up. If you arrive before the store has opened you must pay as soon as the store opens (Shop opening hours are 9am – 6pm Monday – Friday, 9am – 4pm Saturday & Sunday). Please park in the car parks provided. The lay-bys along the lane are not parking spots. Please DO NOT use them as parking spaces.
2. Strictly NO ALCOHOL is allowed on the fishing grounds at any time. If found with alcohol, you will be told to leave. Larton Livery Fisheries do not condone the use of illegal substances. Any permit holder found in possession or under the influence of drugs will be told to leave immediately.
3. Permit holders must always have their ticket on them and produce it upon request by a member of staff. A valid and in date Rod Fishing Licence must be held to fish, this is the law and Larton Livery Ltd will NOT be held responsible if you are caught fishing without one. 4. Permit holders can bring a spectator at the extra cost of £2.00 (this does not allow them to fish).
5. Under 16's must be accompanied by an adult for health and safety reasons.
6. Any permit holder's permit found to be used by anyone other than the permit holder will be cancelled and no refund will be given. Any guest ticket found to be in use by any person other than the person it was originally purchased for by the permit holder will cancel the right of the permit holder to hold a permit.
7. A fishing permit day ticket allows the use of one rod only. There is an additional fee for an extra rod (only one extra rod is permitted per permit holder).
8. Fishing is only permitted on the pegs provided and there must be no excessive moving position from one peg to another.
9. At no time should rods be left unattended in the water.
10. Everyone must have a landing mat, disgorger and must use barbless hooks. The use of keep-nets is forbidden (unless you are competing in a sanctioned fishing match where special permission will be granted).
11. Please note that fish CANNOT be taken away from the Fishing grounds or removed and placed in one of the other ponds. These are strictly catch and release ponds.
12. The use of excessive ground bait is forbidden.
13. Please put your litter in the bins provided or take it home with you. If caught littering, you will be asked to tidy it up, if you do not you will be told to leave immediately.
14. In the interest of health and safety all children must be supervised by an adult at all times. No running or bad behaviour. No cycling. No wading. No swimming.
15. In the event of someone falling into the water there are lifebelts at the main gate. Please inform a member of staff immediately.
16. Night Fishing is not permitted under any circumstances.
17. If the fishing ponds are at max capacity Larton Livery will stop permitting guests until such a time as it is safe to do so.
18. Any permit holder being abusive to staff, other permit holders or members of the public will have their permit revoked without a refund and told to leave. Unacceptable behaviour will not be tolerated.
19. Permit holders fish at their own risk and on the understanding that Larton Livery Ltd accepts no responsibility for loss, damage or injury to person or property.
20. If you see anything which constitutes a risk to yourself or anyone else please report it to a member of staff in the Feed Store or telephone 0151 625 6477. Permit holders are encouraged to report anyone who is not observing the rules.
21. Pets, the lighting of fires and family picnics are forbidden. Please note that Larton Livery is private property and walking around the stable and caravan area is forbidden at all times.
22. Portable radios, CD players, mobile phones or other music devices must not be played out loud. Use of headphones/earphones is fine.
23. Failure to observe these rules may result in the cancellation of your fishing permit and no refund will be given.
24. The owner/management reserves the right to amend the rules whenever they see fit. No prior notices need to be given. This includes price changes, membership charges etc. Please be aware that temporary measures may be put in place at any time by Larton Livery Ltd without any prior notice being given.
